Welcome to the Fall 2017 Session of the St. Cloud PTA After School Program for Enrichment (ASP)! This program strives to provide an enrichment opportunity for our children, so they may explore new ideas, gain new skills and have fun! We are committed to keeping class fees reasonable, while still providing relevant, quality enrichment classes for our children.

The attached course catalog provides descriptions and dates for each class. We've curated a variety of classes in the Arts, STEM, Fitness and just plain fun. Since some classes may fill up quickly, please take a moment to discuss alternate class selections with your child in the event that his or her first choice is unavailable.

There will be an ASP Supervisor on-site to oversee the daily logistics of running the program, and to ensure that no child is left behind or sent home without parental notification. We also coordinate directly with the YMCA After Care program and transfer students as required.

Please note that the St. Cloud PTA, NOT the Board of Education, sponsors the After School Enrichment Program. Therefore, the school nurse is NOT available during program hours.

KEY DATES

Online Registration Opens Sunday, October 1st @ 8:00 am

Classes run from October 11th to December 7th.

Classes held on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. There will be no classes on half-days, when school is closed, or Bring-your-child-to-work Day. See schedule for exact dates per class.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1. If your child has any restrictions/medical issues that could affect his/her experience in the ASP, please email us before registering for a class. We want all students to have the best possible setting for them to learn, interact and have fun. We will work with you and the instructors to confirm that this can be achieved.
- 2. ASP Classes begin at 3:35pm and end at 4:35pm unless specifically advised. Students will be directed where to go when school is dismissed. All kindergarten students will be accompanied and assisted in locating their classrooms.
- 3. **Please pick up your child at his/her ASP classroom**. You can only enter the school through the main door on Sheridan Avenue. Parents must sign out their child in their individual ASP class.
- 4. It is the responsibility of each parent to see that his or her child is picked up promptly at 4:35pm! THERE WILL BE A \$15.00 LATE FEE ASSESSED TO ANY FAMILY PICKING UP THEIR CHILD AFTER 4:35PM. If a parent is continually late in picking up his/her child, the child may be asked to leave the program. If a child is asked to leave, there will be no refund.
- 5. Your child's cooperative attitude and behavior are essential ingredients in our program. One child's disruptive behavior can cause others to be deprived of instruction. Should a problem develop, the parents will be notified. If the problem continues, the child may be asked to leave the program. If a child is asked to leave, there will be no refund. We want to provide a positive experience for all.
- 6. If your child is absent, please call the school to notify the office of your child's absence. Also, if a child is present in school, but needs to miss an ASP class, please send a note to school specifying which class he/she will miss so that the ASP Supervisor is aware of the absence, and so the child is appropriately dismissed by the front office.
- 7. **Refund Policy during Registration Period:** If a parent requests a refund before the registration period ends, a 5% fee will be assessed to cover bank charges. No refunds will be given after close of registration.
- 8. Class Cancellation during Registration Period: In the rare event that the PTA has to cancel a class, we will notify you promptly and work with you to select another class, or refund your payment in full.

GLASS FUSING
