FUNDRAISING

The PTA needs YOU to power the programs and projects supporting St. Cloud School!

The PTA is a non-profit organization. All the programs, events and projects implemented by PTA are funded through fundraising, donations and participation fees (i.e. ticket sales, tuition fees). **The PTA annual fundraising goal is approximately \$45,000** — which translates to roughly \$125 per student.

We do not receive funds from the West Orange school district, the national PTA or St. Cloud school.

Throughout the year, the PTA will implement various fundraisers and raffles to support our budget needs. However, we know that nobody likes to be nagged to give money, so we have several **evergreen fundraising programs** designed to streamline efforts and leverage external funding sources.

- A. No Hassle Fundraiser: We solicit cash donations (\$100+) through the No Hassle Fundraiser. This fundraiser is not about buying stuff, selling stuff or raffles, etc. It is a straightforward mechanism to generate funding for the PTA annual budget. Plus, your participation triggers special rewards for you! —such as: Scholastic Book Fair Coupons and free access to our annual FunFest. Remember to get your donations matched by your employer if your company has a gift matching program. Donate to the No Hassle Fundraiser via the Online School Store on Member Hub.
- B. BoxTops4Education Program: We participate in General Mill's Box Tops which makes a cash donation to St. Cloud for each Box Top certificate scanned from hundreds of product packages. Each box top is worth \$.10 for our school. Download the ALL-NEW Box Tops app, shop as you normally would, then simply scan your store receipts to find participating products. The app will automatically credit your school's Box Tops earnings online.

The PTA earns approximately \$1,000 annually through this program. We have the potential to earn up to \$20,000, so start scanning those receipts and get your extended family and friends involved. (Read more about the program at https://www.boxtops4education.com)

The St. Cloud PTA uses an online communications platform called **Givebacks** to communicate with families and faculty of St. Cloud Elementary School. (This database is separate from the database maintained by the school district. You need to be registered with both.)

- Email blast functionality used to send PTA notices to families
- An online family directory great for planning playdates and parties
- An online school store where you can purchase your PTA membership and spirit wear
- PTA calendar —to keep up with PTA activities and events
- Links and key contacts for St. Cloud school

To ensure your data is 100% accurate, add your family's information to the St. Cloud PTA database on the Givebacks platform.

Note: All data is stored behind secure firewalls and can only be accessed by authorized users with a validated username and encrypted password. All data is viewed and passed using SSL encryption. You will have the option to control the visibility of your data within the platform. If you are asked for teacher information during sign up, leave it blank as you are not likely sure of teacher assignments at this time.

F.A.Q. ABOUT THE ST. CLOUD PTA

Q. Who should join the St. Cloud Elementary School PTA?

A. Anyone affiliated with St. Cloud Elementary School can join the PTA. When you join, you become part of a school wide community committed to elevating the school experience your children have at St. Cloud School.

Our goal is to have 100% of the St. Cloud School families, faculty and administration staff among our active membership.

Many hands make for light work, and the PTA has plenty to do to enrich the lives of St. Cloud School students and families. <u>Your annual membership dues</u>, <u>volunteering</u> and <u>participation in</u> <u>fundraisers</u> help the PTA deliver a wide range of programs across the school year.

Q. I joined the St. Cloud PTA last year, do I have to rejoin?

A. Yes, each school year begins a new membership year. Your membership can be purchased online at stcloudpta.memberhub.store. As this is a new platform, returning members will need to register as well at https://stcloudpta.memberhub.com/join/unwhxp.

Q. If I join the PTA, does it commit me to volunteering or buying stuff?

A. No, volunteering and participation in fundraisers is always optional. However, we <u>always need</u> <u>volunteers</u> for PTA projects and events. And, the PTA uses various fundraisers to support programs such as: approximately 10 school assemblies, 10 family events, etc.

A. What happens at PTA meetings?

Q. Our monthly meetings are open to all parents/guardians of St. Cloud students as well as faculty and administrative staff — regardless of PTA membership status. Meetings are held on weekday evenings at the school. In addition to sharing updates on upcoming programs, these meetings feature a Principal's Report from Mr. Price and a Q&A session.

A. What is my membership fee getting me?

Q. Your membership fee helps fund programs, events and activities for St. Cloud School — and your PTA membership allows you to take advantage of discounts and offers from member benefits providers and sponsors affiliated with the New Jersey PTA.

Q. What is the PTA Executive Board?

A. The PTA Executive Board are parent volunteers who oversee the PTA activities and programs at St. Cloud School. Typically, Executive Board members serve for 2 years. Many board members have previously served as Class Parents or been a volunteer for a PTA program (like the Book Fair or Diversity Night), but not always.
